



ST JOSEPH'S PRIMARY SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPORT

COACH OBLIGATIONS

- Decisions must be fair to all players.
- Coaching comments to be of a positive nature.
- Ensure players have an equal amount of game time.
- Must at all times respect the decisions of the referee.
- Refrain from talking to the referee during match time.
- Be an exemplary role model and teach players the Fair Play and Sportsmanship ideals.
- Ensure no player is left at the courts/pool/turf/field by themselves after the game.

COACH RIGHTS

- A Coach has the right to ask for support from the School Sports Coordinator or lead Teacher should a problem arise.

PLAYERS OBLIGATIONS

- Must at all times respect that the decisions of the referee shall be final.
- Abusive language may not be used towards a referee or other players.
- Wear the correct uniform during games.
- Respect other players, officials, spectators and the facilities.

PLAYERS RIGHTS

- Expect to be treated in a fair and respectful manner and have the support of everyone present.

SPECTATORS/CAREGIVERS OBLIGATIONS

- Will ensure that once your child is selected for a team, they will complete the season.
- Be responsible to make sure your child arrives and is picked up on time for all games and trainings.
- Remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for them, not adults – be a role model.
- Must at all times respect that the decisions of the referee shall be final.
- Abusive language may not be used towards a referee or other players.
- Respect all players, officials, spectators and the facilities.
- Support the Coach of your child's team, communicating respectfully.
- Should an issue arise your School Sports Coordinator is the first point of contact. It is the School's responsibility to contact the competition organiser should any issue arise and need to be resolved.
